

Materials I used

Yarn/Thread-

- Big Twist Value/Value Pound+ (Grey, Pink, Purple)
 - Alt: Any Size 4 (Worsted Weight) Yarn
- Loops and Threads Faux Fur Yarn (White)
 - Alt: Any white faux fur yarn
- White, Pink and Purple Embroidery Thread

Hooks-

- 4.5mm hook
- 3mm hook
- 2mm hook

Misc-

- Scissors
- Cardboard/Cardstock (for the base of the body)
- Darning needle (for weaving in ends/embroidery)

Main Body (Grey Yarn)

1: (In MR) 6sc (6)

2: Inc x6 (12)

3. [sc, inc] x6 (18)

4. [sc, inc, sc] x6 (24)

5. [3sc, inc] x6 (30)

6-10. sc round (30)

11. [3sc, dec] x6 (24)

12. [sc, dec, sc] x6 (18)

13. [sc, inc, sc] x6 (24)

14. [3sc, inc] x6 (30)

15-19. sc round (30)

20. [3sc, dec] x6 (24)

21. [sc, dec, sc] x6 (18)

Cut a circle out of cardboard the size of the body's base, and place inside the bottom part of the body (this will allow it to sit)

Stuff body with polyfill/stuffing of choice

22. [sc, dec] x6 (12)

23. dec x6 (6)

Fasten off and weave in ends

Limbs(x4) (Grey Yarn)

1: (In MR) 6sc (6)

2. Sc round (6)

Fasten off, leaving a longer tail to sew to the body later on

Horns (x2) (Grey and Pink Yarn)

Start with a long MR tail

In Grey

1: (In MR) 6sc (6)

2: Inc x6 (12)

3-4: Sc round (12)

5: [sc, dec] x2, 8sc (10)

Switch to Pink yarn

6: dec, 2sc, dec, 4sc (8)

Stuff with filling

7: dec, 2sc, dec, 2sc (6)

8: sc, 2dec, sc (4)

Fasten off and weave in thread you just cut

Tail (Grey Yarn)

NOTE: Start with a long tail on the initial slipknot (this is what you will use to sew the tail to the netherling's body)

Ch 12

In 2nd chain from hook, begin a [foundation crochet stitch](#). Do one more afterwards and fasten off.

Wing x2 (One in black, the other in purple; Using a 3mm hook)

- The wings for the Netherling uses the pattern from the [Cutie Pocket Bat pattern by AmigurumiToGo](#). If you cannot access the linked website, a screenshot of the pattern is below:

Wings: with body color make 2, I did not design a left and right.

1) ch9

2) starting in 2nd ch, 1sc in the next 3ch, 3sc in the next ch, 1sc in the next 4ch (10) ch1 and turn

3) skip ch, 1sc in next 4st, 3sc in next st, 1sc in next 5st (12)

Working to the left

4) ch1 and 1sc into the next space, ch4 then 1sc into the bottom of the ch, 1sc in the next 3 loops, ch3 then 1sc into the bottom of the ch then 1sc into the same loop, 1sc in the remaining 5 loops. 1sc into the next 2 spaces to the left crocheting over the starting yarn tail to hide it. f/o leaving a tail for sewing. If you are adding in a wire then f/o with a longer tail for sewing the wire in.



After making both wings, sew them together so that the purple wing is on top of the black one (purple is the inside of the wing)

NOTE: When facing the netherling, the wing will be sewn on the left. Make sure you sew the purple wing onto the correct side of the black wing.

Glowy bits (x2) (Using Embroidery Thread and a 2mm hook)

NOTE: Make sure to leave a long tail with the initial MR (this will be used to embroider the netherling's body)

Starting with Pink thread:

1: (In MR) 6sc (6)

2: Inc x6 (12)

Fasten off/weave in end you just cut

Continue with Purple Thread:

3. [sc, inc] x6 (18)

4. [sc, inc, sc] x6 (24)

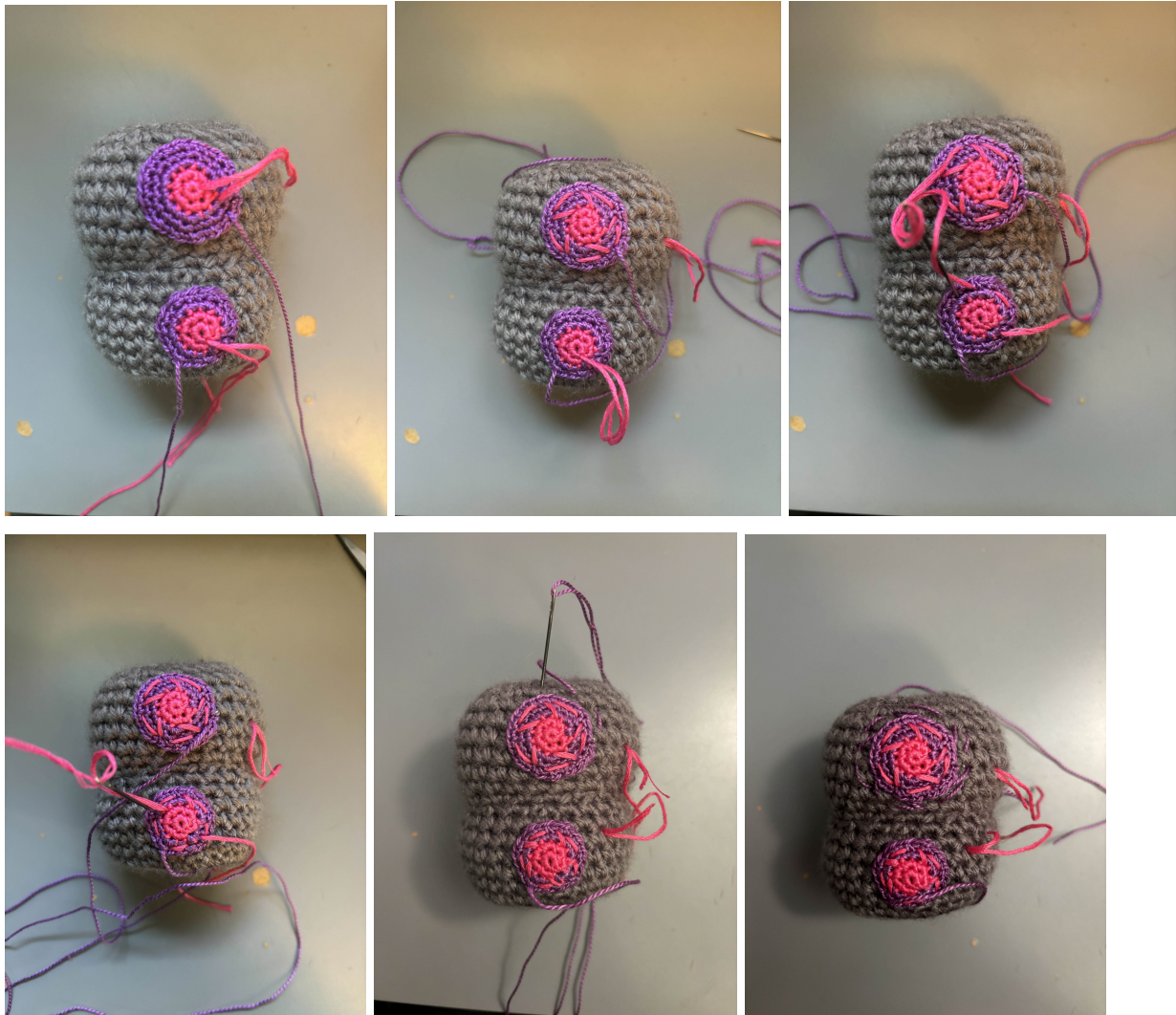
(*Fasten off here/leave a long tail for embroidering for the first one*. This one is for the body)

5. [3sc, inc] x6 (30)

Fasten off

Assembly

Using the tails from the glowy bits, sew them onto the body of the Netherling's body as shown below. I also used the tails to embroider lines for a "gradient" style effect on/around the glowy bits (**NOTE:** The Bigger glowy bit goes on the Netherling's head, and the smaller one goes on the body)



- After you are done, tie off and weave in ends

Using the photos below as reference, sew on the horns, limbs, wings, and tail onto the netherling (+tie off/weave in any remaining ends). Cut a piece of faux fur yarn long

enough to wrap around the Netherling's "neck" twice (or long enough to make it look fluffy), and attach.

Finally, use a white piece of crochet or embroidery thread to sew the highlight onto the Netherling's face. Use a black piece of thread to sew on its mouth.



And with that, you're done! You now have a little lad who will commit arson and various other crimes with or without your approval. Feel free to modify this pattern to create a

Netherram for your Sona (change the colors, horn shape/position, wing quantity, etc). Also tag me if you end up posting your finished result! I'd love to see it :D
